7:00 PM **Parade Rolls** – Start at corner of N. Albina Avenue & Humboldt Street (by Victoria Bar & Neil Kelly Company).

Parade end - Corner of N. Cook St. & Mississippi Avenue (by Ecliptic Brewing, 825 Cooks St). The parade should last about an hour.

Route - 13 blocks on N. Albina & Mississippi Avenues.)

It's close quarters on N. Mississippi Ave. on Parade night so carpooling, ride sharing, or public transportation are good options.

The #4 TriMet bus line runs right down the center of Parade route on Mississippi & Albina Avenues.

PUBLIC Transit MAX or Bus - <https://trimet.org/home/planner>

- Downtown Portland – 30 mins: Tri Met bus #4 Leaving every 15 mins on a Tues. night, take the #4 Fessenden to N. Albina & Alberta
- Downtown Portland – 25 mins: MAX yellow line to Overlook Park Station, walk .5 mile, cross Failing St Bridge
- Hollywood district – 23 mins: Ride MAX (any line) to Rose Quarter. Transfer to #4 bus
- St Johns – 40 mins
- Tri Met bus #4 Leaving every 20 mins.

Parking – Slim to no chance of parking on N. Mississippi Ave past 6:00 PM. Plan to park on the west side of I-5 and walk over the Failing Street Bridge. Enjoy your walk and park on N Albina, Borthwick, Kerby, Commercial or Haight streets.
